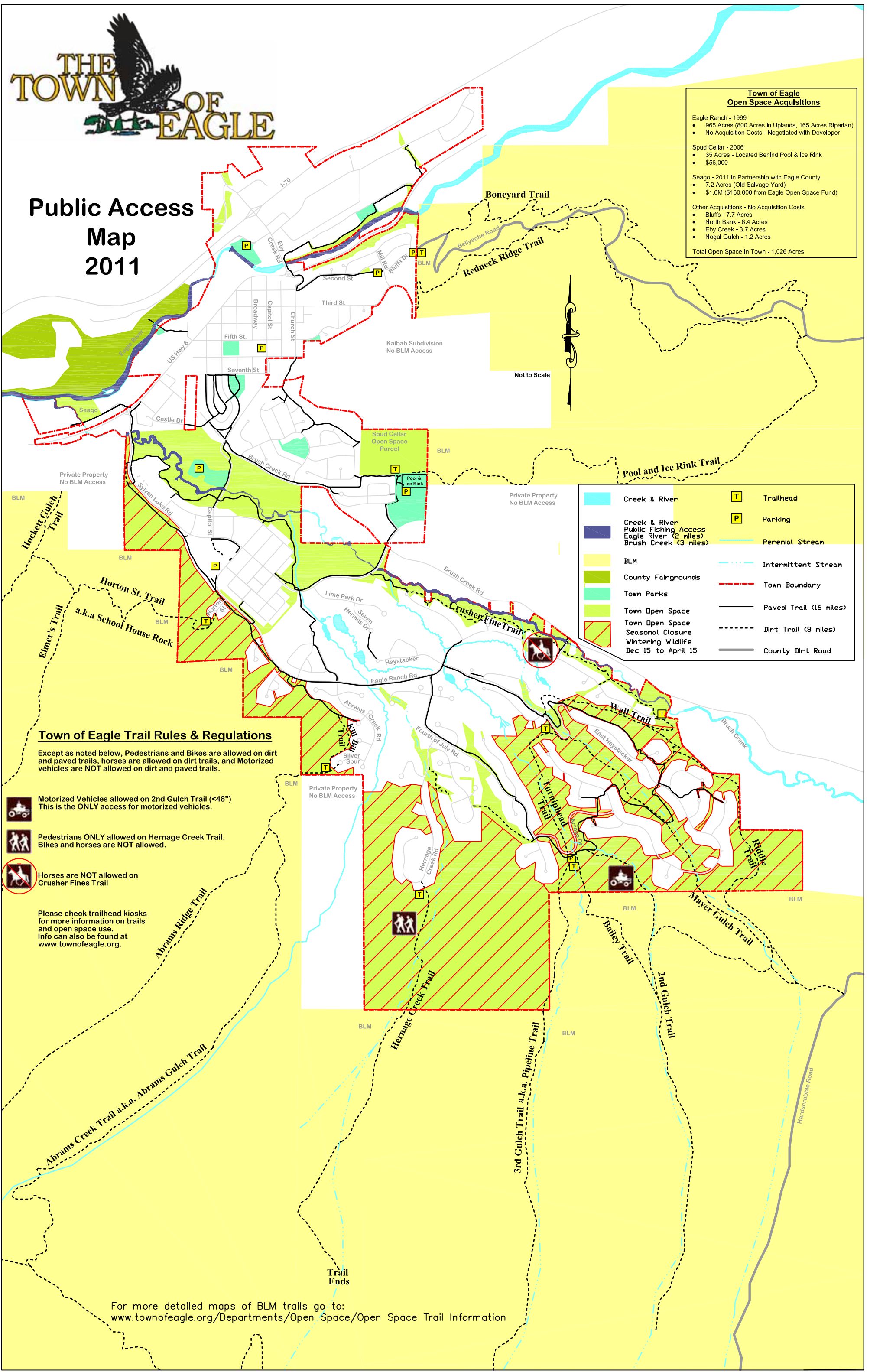


## Public Access Map 2011

**Town of Eagle Open Space Acquisitions**

- Eagle Ranch - 1999
  - 965 Acres (800 Acres in Uplands, 165 Acres Riparian)
  - No Acquisition Costs - Negotiated with Developer
- Spud Cellar - 2006
  - 35 Acres - Located Behind Pool & Ice Rink
  - \$56,000
- Seago - 2011 in Partnership with Eagle County
  - 7.2 Acres (Old Salvage Yard)
  - \$1.6M (\$160,000 from Eagle Open Space Fund)
- Other Acquisitions - No Acquisition Costs
  - Bluffs - 7.7 Acres
  - North Bank - 6.4 Acres
  - Eby Creek - 3.7 Acres
  - Nogal Gulch - 1.2 Acres

### Town of Eagle Trail Rules & Regulations

Except as noted below, Pedestrians and Bikes are allowed on dirt and paved trails, horses are allowed on dirt trails, and Motorized vehicles are NOT allowed on dirt and paved trails.

Motorized Vehicles allowed on 2nd Gulch Trail (<48") This is the ONLY access for motorized vehicles.

Pedestrians ONLY allowed on Hernage Creek Trail. Bikes and horses are NOT allowed.

Horses are NOT allowed on Crusher Fines Trail
